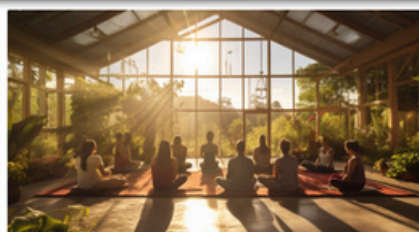

Provides governance oversight	Provides expertise and strategic input
Approves budgets, legal compliance, and strategic plans	Supports fundraising, partnerships, and key initiatives
Votes on major financial and mission-related decisions	Connects GWFBOB with networks and funding opportunities
Oversees leadership, impact measurement, and sustainability	Serves in specialized Advisory Groups based on expertise
Requires active participation in board meetings and decision-making	Offers flexible involvement based on expertise and availability

- Attend quarterly board meetings (virtual or in-person).
- Oversee financials, governance, and strategic growth.
- Actively participate in fundraising, donor relations, and sponsorship outreach.
- Provide an annual contribution or help secure funding to sustain GWFBOD's impact.

Board Member Responsibilities

- Serve as an expert resource and connector in your field.
- Attend advisory meetings (optional participation).
- Support fundraising, partnership-building, and strategic initiatives.
- Assist in outreach, program development, or event planning as needed.
